City Involvement

The City is also planning to request funds from the Tourism Board this January for the purpose of installing more electric in the park. This will increase availability of areas to decorate. We are hoping for more future community involvement decorating process.



Election Filing Closing— The filing closing date is January 17, 2012, for candidates to file for the offices of Council in wards I, II, III, and IV and City Treasurer for the election on April 3, 2012. The filing fee for both City Council and City Treasurer are \$25.

Candidates— The candidates that have currently filed are the incumbent from Ward I Gary Underwood; the incumbent from Ward II Kathy Murphy; and the incumbent from Ward IV lim Tinnin. No one has filed for Ward III or for the City Treasurer.

Gannon Avenue Enhancement **Project Update**— The second bid process for this project was successful in receiving one that was within the budget. The bulk of the work is to be done on East Gannon, which is the section from A Highway near the bank around to YMCA Drive. There will be some work on West Gannon, but traffic will never be completely blocked. Lanes will remain open at all times. This project will possibly begin at the end of March and is expected to be completed in the summer of 2012.

The old banners deteriorate Police Department would like to advise residents to be mindful of locking vehicles. There has been an increase of vehicle thefts lately. Ten guns have been stolen out of vehicles in the last six weeks. encourage residents to notify the Police Department of any strange activity in their neighborhoods.

Snow Routes- With the harshest couple of months of the year upon us, we would like to inform residents of the snow route procedures. We are hoping that this information will help residents plan ahead for parking when a snow or ice storm is predicted.

- Primary streets are plowed first. These include N Mill, S Mill, N 6th, N 9th, N 5th, Central Ave, Horine, Cromwell, N Adams, S Adams, Main Street, Sunshine, Hillsboro, Collins, Pounds, Gamel Cemetery, N 2nd, Walnut, Vine, Harrison, Scenic Drive, YMCA Drive, Gannon, N Creek, and Lee Ave.
- Secondary streets are plowed after primary streets by simply fanning out from the primary streets. The snow plows are split into quadrants.
- Alleys & small side streets are plowed last.

Ways Residents Can Help Out:

- It would be helpful on streets, such as Lee Ave, for cars to be parked as close to the curbs as possible. This makes it safer for the plows and less likely to cause damage to your vehicles.
- If you have an option to park off of the streets, please do
- Please do not shovel snow into the streets. It is best to shovel the snow into your front yards.

We hope this year isn't as hazardous as the last, and please be careful to drive slowly in case there is black ice on the roads.
